

HOW DID YOU START WITH PHOTOGRAPHY?

I have always been interested in photography as far as I can remember. I used to capture family and school trip images on a Kodak film camera back in the 90s but my real passion towards photography started after I started working as an engineer. At that time, I was searching for some hobby to destress and I found photography again. What started with normal sunset, sunrise, and vacation images, they eventually formed into abstract and art images. The journey still goes on with learning and observing.

HAVE YOU HAD FORMAL TRAINING IN PHOTOGRAPHY?

I have had a basic course of how a DSLR works and deeper nuances in websites, articles, youtube and tips and tricks by fellow travellers on jungle safari trips. I feel self-learning is the most important form of keeping updated with photography.

WHAT'S YOUR BIGGEST CHALLENGE YOU HAD TO OVERCOME IN YOUR PHOTOGRAPHY CAREER?

In the beginning it was the gear. To get a body and the lens of your choice has always been a tough deal as I am not a professional and not affiliated to camera companies. The second has been selecting travel journeys to places that one wants to photograph, also in wild-life photography whereby one is always dependent on natural history moments happening in front of you and the light, of course. Light can make or break an image and its always luck whether you are at a right place at a right time or not.

WHERE DO YOU FIND YOUR INSPIRATION?

Nature has been my biggest inspiration in my brief journey of photography. I've been deeply inspired by how we are driven by nature right from our beginning to the end. All the natural elements viz. sun, wind, trees, mountains, and sky inspire me and make me tell their versions of stories. The way a tree has seen the land around it or how wind shapes the landscapes are such amazing stories of inspiration. One can just keep wondering in awe when it comes to nature.







HOW MUCH EMPHASIS YOU PUT ON POST PROCESSING?

Raw photos will always need processing! Also, one must know that to convert normal photos into works of art, one always need processing. There is a fine line of where one has to stop processing an image, but its important to edit an image with a purpose whether it is art or a documentary image. One must not add or remove elements with the purpose of twisting the reality of an image. If one maintains the reality of the story, editing to make an image beautiful is certainly necessary.

WHAT GENRE WOULD YOU MOSTLY LIKE TO EXPERIMENT IN?

Wildlife and astro landscapes. I love to shoot wildlife in different terrains around the world in their habitat and also love to experiment around with multiple exposures and panning. Astro landscapes is something of a speciality genre where one is dependent on moon phases and the Milky Way but is extremely satisfying to create an astro landscape scene.

DO YOU HAVE A FAVOURITE WALKAROUND LENS? IF SO WHAT IS IT?

I have different choices for this, depending on genres. If the general purpose is to shoot then I'd go with a 24-70mm range. If I am on a wildlife safari then I'd love to have a prime lens with me.

HAVE YOU GOT ANY HINTS AND TIPS FOR ASPIRING PHOTOGRAPHERS?

Read – read the camera manuals, websites on how your camera bodies work. Read about focusing and metering and Iso of your camera to use it at an optimum level. It's extremely necessary to know all these nuances to make sure you don't use the auto mode on your camera.

Practice – click as much as you can and make sure you don't have to remove your eyes and fingers from the camera, know all the buttons. Every setting and buttons should be in muscle memory of your fingers so one does not miss any chances when the moment comes.

Editing – learn to edit and make an image beautiful and make sure that the originality and the story of the image remains intact. It's unethical to add or remove elements to twist your tale of the image.

Community – form a community where you can honestly discuss your images, get a true feedback on your work and improve collectively. It's important to know we are going ahead in the right direction, so discussion of new ideas, execution with the right set of people is important.

WHAT HAVE BEEN YOUR BIGGEST MARKETING TOOLS IN LAST FEW YEARS?

I'd say websites like 1x.com, 500px. com, and Flickr for uploading high resolution images. Facebook and Instagram for low resolution and networking work.

HOW DOES PHOTOGRAPHY INFLUENCE YOUR LIFE?

It's an escape for me. From my realties. It allows my imagination and creativity to have a physical form when I print an image and frame it. Photography has also taught me to "see". Even when I am not carrying my camera, I keep seeing the light and try to frame things and see how they can be seen more aesthetically. When I watch movies it gives me a chance to see how the cinematographer has composed the scene to convey the meaning of the scene more effectively. working out.




















































































GROUP RULES

Only ONE single image is allowed per day. Diptychs are allowed as long as they are on one single image. Sharing of links, public posts from outside the Group, or screenshots are not allowed. Post your best work, preferably with a title. Please avoid the repetition of the same subject or

2. AUTHORSHIP OF IMAGES, SIGNATURES

Post your OWN work only. Members who upload work that is not theirs are solely accountable for possible copyright infringements and will be banned from the Group. Logos or signatures inserted in images must be your own. They must be discreet and non-distracting. Please avoid the addition of frames.

3. BE BENEVOLENT

We all participate in this Group by creating a friendly environment. Let us show respect to all. Healthy disagreements are acceptable, but courtesy is essential. There is zero tolerance for rude or aggressive behavior in our Group.

4. PHOTO RESOLUTION, MOBILE

Recommended photo resolution is 2048px wide. Images of a resolution of 1400px min. maybe accepted as long as they are sharp and clear. Whatever the case, bad quality photos will be rejected for publishing on the Group's Gallery and Magazine. Facebook will downgrade uploads from mobiles down to 960px. In your mobile settings, you can switch to

"Upload HD" and your images of sufficient resolution will be transcoded in a higher resolution. The other option is already rejected image. to upload from a computer.

5. TECHNICAL QUALITY, ARTISTIC

IMAGeNATION aims to showcase the absolute best in photographic art. Our award-winning admins are very selective and will reject any uploads they consider to be of poor technical quality and/or artistic skills. Their decisions are final and indisputable and they are NOT obliged to explain their decisions to any member. Regarding selections. images are shortlisted and chosen on their own merits, not on the number of likes. Uploads by the admins are excluded from the selection process.
